

# ISAAC COLE BAND – STAGE SETUP

Isaac Cole – Lead vocals, electric guitar, acoustic guitar, 2 fiddles

- Isaac will be center stage, he will have his own electric guitar amp and chords.
- He will need a vocal microphone and stand.
- He will need a microphone for his electric guitar amp.
- He will need a DI box for his acoustic guitar.
- He will need a DI box for his fiddle(s). (A stereo DI box is great, but he can switch fiddles to the same DI box if necessary.)

Lead Guitar and vocals

- He will need a vocal microphone and stand.
- He will need a microphone for his electric guitar amp.

Keyboard and vocals

- He will need a vocal microphone and stand.
- He will need at least one DI box. We prefer a stereo DI box but we can make Mono work.

Bass (no vocals)

- He will need an XLR out.

Drums (no vocals)

- If possible, set drums left or right of center stage (IF there is room).
- Drum microphones as needed to provide sound to the house/venue.

General Notes:

- Most of our drummers use a hardwire in ear system.
- All the other band members are using Sennheiser XSW In Ear Monitors, so if the sound engineer has the same, we can just pair our body packs to their system.
- We also have a 16 channel QSC board we use when we provide our own sound, and it has 2 – 8 channel splitters that we can use, but it will limit the number of drum microphones we can feed to the house.
- The band can also use floor monitors, but prefer to use in ears.
